
INTRODUCTION

This guide will show you how to remove the soleplate on the bottom of the vacuum. This is easily done by removing 3 plastic fasteners that lock the soleplate in place. Follow the steps below to see how this is done.





Step 1 — Sole Plate



- Lay the vacuum on its side to allow for easy access to the bottom of the cleaner head.
- Unlock the sole plate by using <u>a</u> <u>quarter</u> or other flat tool to turn the three plastic bolts counterclockwise, as indicated on the sole plate.
- The plastic fasteners can be damaged when using a metal tool to turn them.

Step 2



• Gently pull off the sole plate

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
