INTRODUCTION

Replace the speakers to improve the sound quality of your device.



TOOLS:

- Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)
- Soldering Iron (1)



• Solder (1)

Step 1 — Auxiliary Speakers



- Power off the device before beginning disassembly.
 - Using a Phillips #00 Screwdriver, take out the following screws:
 - Two 6 mm screws
 - Three 4 mm screws
 - Four 3 mm screws
- i These screws can be taken out in any order.

Step 2



 Using a Phillips #00 Screwdriver, remove the screws located under the top two standoffs.

Step 3



 Remove the cover off the back of the device.

Step 4




 Two speakers can be found on the device, one in the lower-right corner and one in the lower left-corner.

Step 5



 Gently pull up on the speaker to remove it. Repeat this for the other speaker.

Step 6



- De-solder the red and black wires to disconnect the old speaker.
- ♠ Be careful while using a soldering iron as it is extremely hot.
