This guide will illustrate how to replace the Wi-Fi or Bluetooth card in the laptop.

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
INTRODUCTION

Installing a new Wi-Fi card can improve your internet connection speed as well as maintain a reliable connection. First we will open the back of the laptop. After, we can easily unscrew and remove the Wi-Fi card.

PARTS:


Intel Wireless-AC 7260NGW (1)

Step 1 — Wi-Fi/Bluetooth Card





Step 2




 Locate the Wi-Fi/Bluetooth card, and remove the two wires connected to the card with your hands.

Step 3



 Unscrew the single 2.5x6mm holding down the card onto the board with your Philips #0 screwdriver.

Step 4



- Remove/unhinge the card from the board by gently lifting it upwards.
- Replace it with your new card.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
