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
INTRODUCTION

This guide will show you how to remove and replace the speakers.

TOOLS:


iFixit Opening Tool (1)
TR10 Torx Security Screwdriver (1)
1 x Hex3mm Screwdriver (1)
Tweezers (1)

Step 1 — Case



 Remove the four 3 mm screws located in each corner using a 3 mm Hex screwdriver.

Step 2





- Gently pull up and off the outer casing.
- (i) Do not feel afraid to use a bit of force if necessary.

Step 3





- Remove the internal device from the outer casing.
- Remove the four 12 mm screws on each corner using a T10 Torx screwdriver.
- Remove the eight 6 mm screws on the top and bottom using a T10 Torx screwdriver.

Step 4







- Use your hands to gently remove the side plates.
 - Use an opening tool to pry off the back plate with the Fugoo trademark.


Step 5



- Slowly pull the front casing from the back casing. Avoid putting any tension on the connected cables.
- ⚠ Separate the two slowly and consistently to avoid damaging the speaker cables.


Step 6 — Speaker





- Carefully untangle the wires that are connected from the speaker to the motherboard.
- Using a tweezer, pull downwards on the base of each red speaker connector to remove them from the motherboard.

Step 7







- Use a #3 Hex screwdriver to unscrew all six 3mm screws."
- While holding the case with one hand, pull up on the speaker you wish to replace.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
