

Microsoft Band 2 Screen Replacement

This guide will cover how to remove the screen...

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
INTRODUCTION

This guide will cover how to remove the screen of the Microsoft Band 2 smartwatch. If the display is blank or dim it may be advantageous to consider replacing the screen on the Band 2.

TOOLS:

Heat Gun (1)
Spudger (1)
iFixit Opening Picks (Set of 6) (1)
Tweezers (1)

Step 1 — Screen



- ⚠ Wear proper gloves when using a heatgun.
- Use a heatgun to melt the adhesive beneath the screen.
 Heat the metal around edges of the screen.
- (i) Avoid heating the rubber watch band as it will quickly melt.
- i Heating the LCD screen may damage it. Avoid this procedure unless you intend to replace the screen.

Step 2



 Use a <u>spudger</u> and plastic <u>opening picks</u> to pry the screen away from the Band 2.

Step 3





• Use metal <u>tweezers</u> to gently detach the orange press-fit (or "pop") connector.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
