INTRODUCTION

Replacing suction seal which is the cause of loss performance and/or air leak.



TOOLS:


Metal Spudger (1)

Step 1 — Suction Rubber Seal




 Press to blue unlock buttons at the base of the nozzle in word and pull forward.

Step 2



Locate rubber suction seal.

Step 3



 Insert a metal spudger in between white plastic and rubber seal and gently drag spudger around see you lifting gently much like opening a can.

Step 4



- Align slits on the bottom of new suction seal then press into those slits.
- The seal should not come above white plastic.
- If the nozzle does not connect to vacuum barrel, readjust seal and try to attach nozzle until it snaps into place.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
