# **TOOLS:**

• T10 Torx Screwdriver (1)



#### **PARTS:**

 Dyson DC65, DC66 and UP13 Animal Brushbar (1)

## Step 1 — Brushbar





Turn off and unplug the vacuum.

## Step 2






Recline the vacuum on its back and position the brushbar up in the air.


## Step 3






Pull the red ring around the base of the brush head down and away from the body.

## Step 4




 Pull the brushbar out from the vacuum.

## Step 5




 Pull up the red tabs on the top of the brushbar.


# Step 6




 Remove the front panel of the brushbar.

#### Step 7









Remove the four screws with a Torx T10 Screwdriver.

## Step 8





- Lift the brushbar away from the housing while pulling it out to the side.
- (i) This may take some force and wiggling.
