

# **PARTS:**


ASUS VivoBook Q200E Fan (1)

#### Step 1 — Back Panel



- Turn off the computer and unplug the charge cable.
- If the computer is on or plugged in, it could cause electric shock.
- Turn the computer upside down.

#### Step 2



 Remove the nine Philips #00 screws holding the back panel in place (four 5.6mm, four 7.7mm, and one 9.2mm).


# Step 3






Use a plastic opening tool to gently remove the back panel.

# Step 4 — Cooling Fan




 Unscrew the five 4.9mm screws holding the cooling fan in place using a Phillips #0 screwdriver.

# Step 5



Unplug the power bus for the fan.

# Step 6



 Lift up and remove the cooling fan from the slot.
