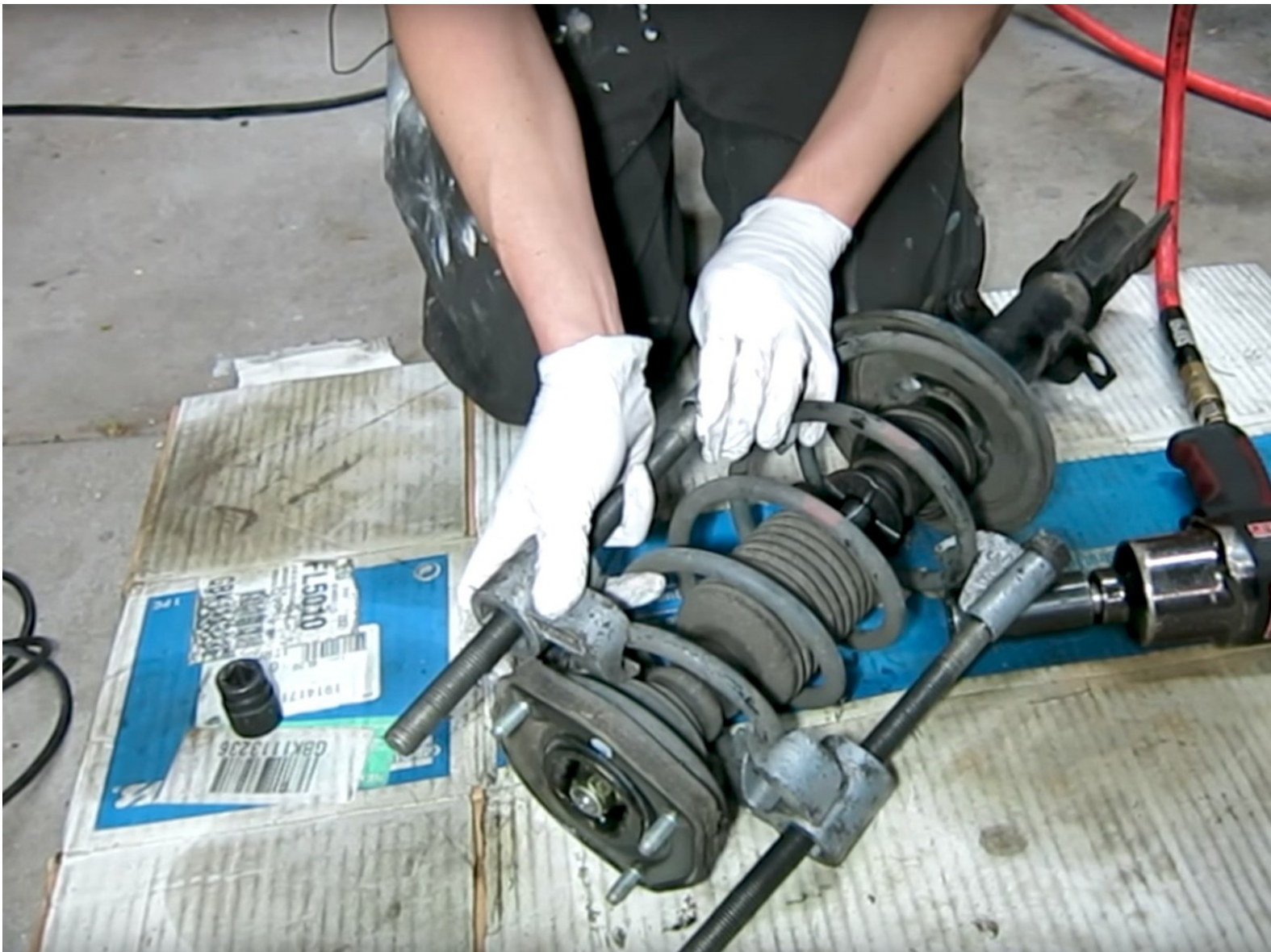




1993-1997 Toyota Corolla Rear Strut Replacement
