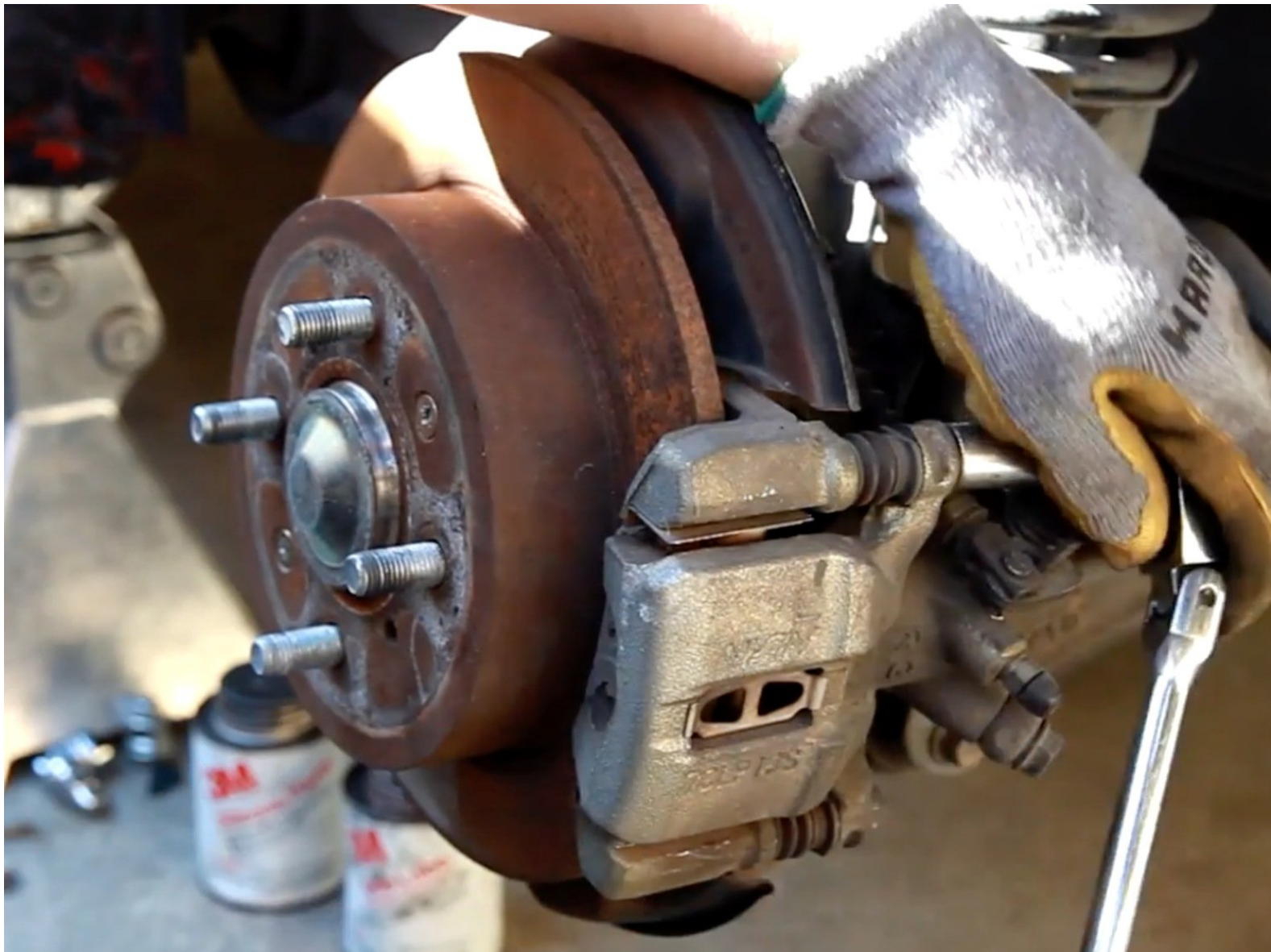




1994-2001 Acura Integra Rear Brake Pad and Rotor Replacement
