INTRODUCTION

HP Pavilion Wave comes with a pair of built-in mouse and keyboard. This guide shows you how to replace them without using any additional USB-port for your mouse and keyboard.



TOOLS:

- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)
- iFixit Opening Tool (1)



PARTS:

Wireless keyboard and mouse (1)


Step 1 — Front IO Board





- Turn over the computer and remove the rubber feet.
- Remove the 8mm Philips screws indicated in red circles with a Philips #0 screwdriver.
- Use a pry tool and lift the lid.







Pry open the casing from the back of the IO panel, as shown in the pictures.

• Finally, remove the two cables circled in red from the front IO panel.

Step 4 — **Mouse and Keyboard adapter**



 Locate a blue USB adapter on the left side of the hard disk compartment.

- Take off the USB with gentle but firm pressure.
- (i) This is a single USB adapter for both mouse and keyboard, so you must get a wireless mouse and keyboard pair, or you will have to use the extra USB for the other one.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
