

Dyson DC56 Battery Replacement

This guide will show you steps to remove the battery from the Dyson DC56.

INTRODUCTION

The battery is what makes this vacuum handheld and portable. It can keep the vacuum operational for approximately 3.5 hours.



TOOLS:

Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)



PARTS:

Dyson DC56 Replacement Battery (1)

Step 1 — Battery



- Make sure the vacuum is unplugged from charger.
- Warning: Avoid pressing red trigger because the vacuum will turn on the device and begin suction.

Step 2



 Locate the purple button at the top of the device.

Step 3



 Separate the device with the purple button.

Step 4



Take out the filter.

Step 5



Locate and remove the 10mm
Phillips head screw using a Phillips
#1 screw driver.

Step 6 — Battery screw 2



 Locate and remove #000 25mm phillips screw on the reverse side of the vacuum

Step 7



 Pull the battery pack down and away from the main body and remove it from the device.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
