INTRODUCTION

If the ports on the I/O board are broken or any other components have failed, the I/O board may need replacement. Follow the steps in this guide to replace the I/O board in your SHIELD TV.



TOOLS:

- T6 Torx Screwdriver (1)
- iFixit Opening Tools (1)

Step 1 — I/O Board



 Flip the device over and use a plastic opening tool to remove the bottom cover.


Step 2





Remove the indicated cables and ribbon wires.

Step 3





Remove the indicated four screws using the T6 Torx screwdriver.

Step 4



 Carefully tilt and pull out the I/O board from the device.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
