## **INTRODUCTION**

The Baby Unit Microphone is vital because it allows you to communicate between the two monitors in different rooms. You will need a soldering kit to successfully install a new microphone.



Tweezers (1)
Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)
Soldering Iron (1)

## Step 1 — Baby Unit Microphone








- Using precision <u>tweezers</u>, remove the four rubber feet from the bottom of the baby unit.
- Using a Phillips #1 screwdriver, remove the 9.5mm screws that were under the rubber feet.
- Open the base of the baby unit.

## Step 2



- Desolder the wires connecting the microphone to the circuit board.
- $\triangle$  Beware of overheating, the soldering kit is capable of damaging the circuit board.
- $\triangle$  Beware of the potential for personal injury from heated metals.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
