INTRODUCTION

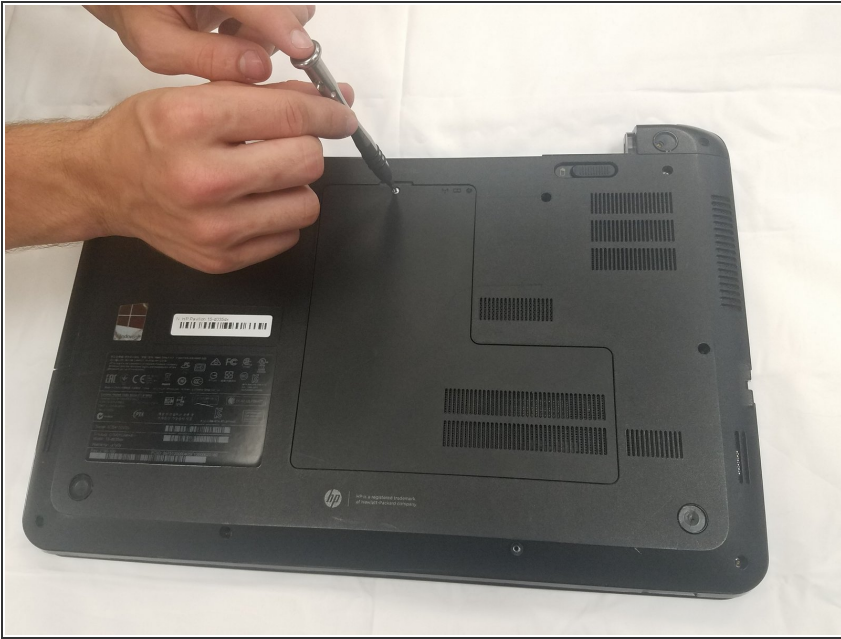
In this guide it teaches how to remove the back panel of the laptop. You will need a screwdriver and a opening tool to complete this task.



TOOLS:

Step 1 — Back Panel



- Flip the laptop so that the back is facing upwards.
- Locate the small screw on the back that holds the "L" shaped panel.
- Using a 0 Phillips Screwdriver (4.0x4.7mm sized screw), unscrew the screw. It will not become detached from the panel but it will allow you to remove the back panel.

Step 2



- Using a plastic opening tool, pry the back panel from the computer, going all the way around it.



This will take a good amount of force and you will hear clicking noises as you snap each of the connections out of place.

Step 3



- Once the back panel is completely removed you will have access to the RAM and many other connections in the computer.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
