

Dell Inspiron 13-5368 Screen Display Replacement

A simple guide on how to remove and replace your Dell Inspiron 13-5368 Screen Display.

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INTRODUCTION


This is a simple step-by-step guide on how to remove and replace a screen display for a Dell Inspiron 13-5368. You will need a Philips Head J-0 screwdriver and a pry tool in order to perform this task. This task requires a great amount of care because you are working with glass. The time needed to complete this task is approximately 10 minutes.



TOOLS:


- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)
- iFixit Opening Tools (1)

Step 1 — Battery




Remove the nine 6mm Phillips #0 screws that secure the back cover of the laptop.

Step 2




Use a spudger to pry up and remove the back cover.




 Remove the four 3mm Phillips #0 screws at the corners of the battery that secure it to the laptop.

Step 4



- Pull the battery cable's black tab towards the battery to disconnect it from the motherboard.
 - Pull the tab parallel to the motherboard, not straight up.





Remove the battery.


Step 6 — Screen Display








 Unscrew the 2mm screw that holds the WLAN card. Then carefully remove the WLAN card from the motherboard.




 Detach the black and white antenna cables from the WLAN card.

Step 8



Unplug the two display cables.



 Unscrew the screws that are securing the laptop's hinges.

Step 10



Detach the display from the base.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
